**FOR FURTHER THOUGHT:**

1. How many different types (version, format) of Bible can you name? How many do you own? Which is your favorite? What have been some things that have encouraged you toward a greater devotion to God’s Word? If you were to help someone grow in that area, what would you suggest?
2. Look at Luke 1:26-38. What might have been some of the thoughts that came to Mary’s mind when the angel told her she was going to have a baby? Do you think she might have preferred another way? What does her response in v38 suggest? Compare with Luke 22:42. Can you think of a time when you said to God, “Not my will but Yours be done”?
3. Read Romans 12:1-2. How can we know God’s will for our lives?
4. Read Mary’s song in Luke 1:46-55. What’s the theme? How does it help us to understand God’s way? Compare with Mark 9:33-35, and James 4:6.
5. Have you ever been excited about a vision, only to see it die? What was that like? Have you seen God turn a tough situation around?
6. What are some opportunities for servanthood that you can live out this week?
7. Pray that this week you will find opportunities to demonstrate the way of humble service.
